**Block of the Month: "Casey's Camp"**

**Block Due March 3, 2010**

Finished: 12" Unfinished: 12½"

## Fabric Required:

Fabrics A and C: medium contrast warm tones (reds, oranges, or rust)

Fabric B: beige background

Fabric D: dark brown – center four-patch



### Fabric A – Medium Print ✂

- Cut: Four 3½" squares
- Cut: Two 2" x 15" strips (length is approximate –for strip piecing)



### Fabric B – Beige Background ✂

- Cut: Two 4" squares
- Cut: Two 2" x 15" strips (length is approximate –for strip piecing)



### Fabric C – Medium Contrast ✂

(will go in the center four-patch)

- Cut: Two 2⅝" squares



### Fabric D – Dark Brown ✂

(will go in the center four-patch)

- Cut: Two 2⅝" squares



## Step 1: Make Side Units – Make 4



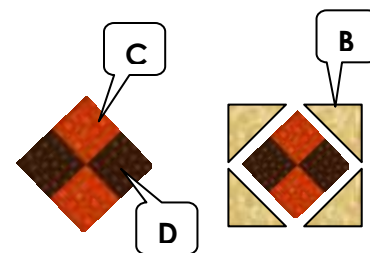
- Sew Fabric A and Fabric B strips together along the long edge. Press towards Fabric A. Cut into four 6½" pieces.



## Step 2: Center "Square in a Square" – Make 1



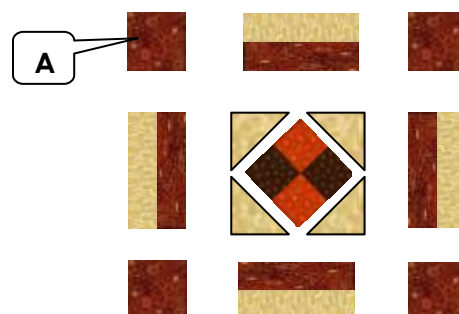
- Sew the 2⅝" squares of Fabrics C and D together to make a four-patch. Press toward the darker fabric (Fabric D).
- Cut the two 4" squares of Fabric B (background) corner to corner once two yield four triangles.
- Sew these triangles to opposite sides of the four-patch. Press to light (background). Trim by "squaring up" to 6½" square (a 6½" square ruler works great for this).



## Step 3: Assemble the Block



- See diagram for block construction. Press rows as indicated.
