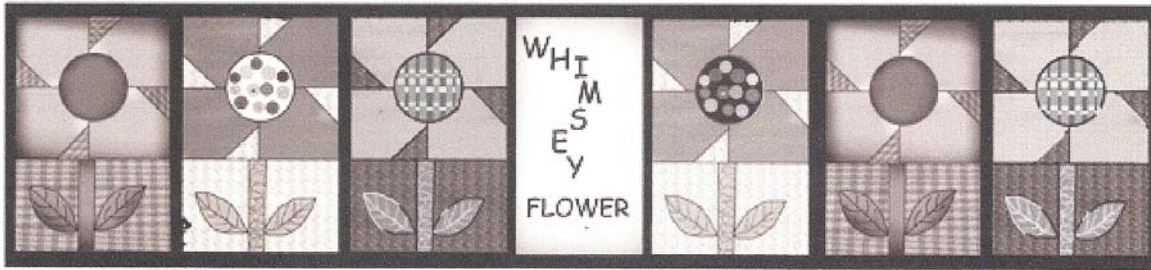


March Block of the Month Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County

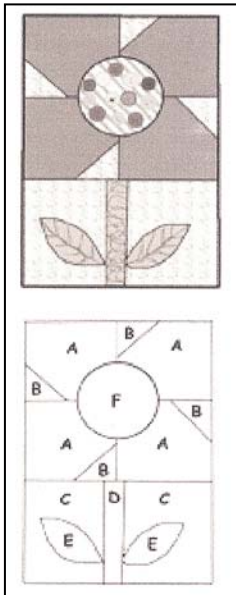
Block size: 9 1/2" x 15 1/4" unfinished

Due: March 4, 2009

Here's a chance to be creative by choosing color and fabric of your choice. Select something bright for the flower, then a high contrast for the background. Leaves can be green, but you can think outside the box and use any color. Add decorative elements, such as beads, buttons, rick-rack, yo-yos, etc. to the flower and/or the background. The flower's center can be a circle, star, circle within a circle, or any other shape you like.



The leaves and flower center are appliquéd or can be fused.



Flower A - cut four 5" squares

Background B - cut four 2 1/2" squares

Background C - cut two 4 1/2" x 6 1/4" rectangles

Stem D - cut one 1 1/2" x 6 1/4" piece

Leaves E - cut 2 according to the pattern given on next page

Flower center F - can be a circle, star, etc. of any

size you wish

Place square B on corner of square A

Sew diagonal corner to corner and trim to 1/4"

Press open. Make 4
