Block of the Month

Wreath

Due November 4, 2009

This is a simple wreath block. Decorate to your heart's content. Some suggestions – yo-yos, fusible designs, beads, bows, embroidery, appliqué. Your options are unlimited. Have fun!

Supplies:

Color 1: white-on-white

Color 2: green – fabric that reads green



Cut:

white-on-white: four 3½" squares

white-on-white: one 6½" square

Green: two 12½" x 3½" rectangles

Green: two 6½" x 3½" rectangles

Green: four 3½" squares

Sewing Instructions:

Rows 1 and 3 are identical: Use ¼" seam allowance. Mark diagonal line on wrong side of 3½" white-on-white squares. Attach 3½" squares to corners of 12½" green rectangles and sew on diagonal line. Trim to ¼" from seam and press toward corners as shown.

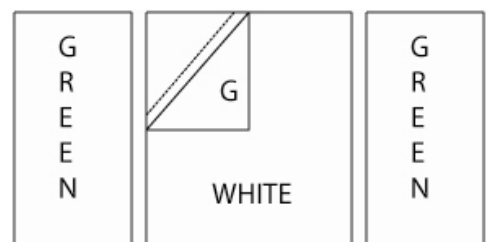
Row 2: Mark diagonal line on wrong side of 3½" green squares. Place a 3½" green square face down on the 6½" white-on-white square. Stitch on diagonal line and cut ¼" from seam line. Press toward corner. Repeat on all four corners. Sew, cut, and press each corner separately. Attach one 6½" green rectangle to each side of the 6½" white-on-white center square and press away from center as shown.

Connect each row to complete block.
