

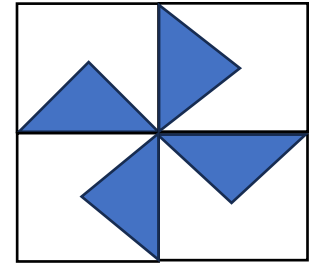
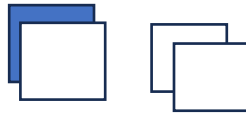
# Moonlight Quilters – Due March 5

## Turnstile

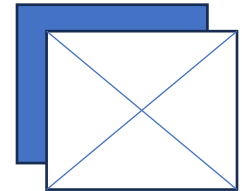
10.5" Unfinished

Fabric required:

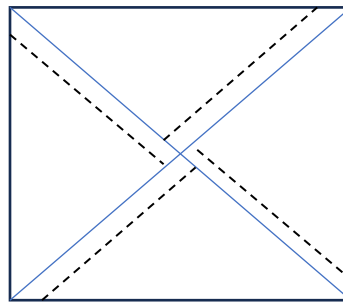
- 1 White Background 6.5 inch square
- 1 Color, small print 6.5 inch square
- 2 White Background 6.25 inch square



Mark the back of the 6.5 inch white square with diagonal lines from corner to corner. To make four half triangles with the color fabric all on the same side we have to Sew this with seams only to the mid point to the right of the drawn line.

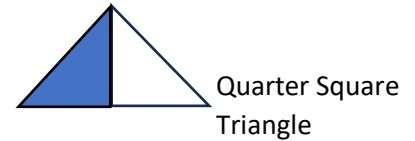


Place the color square and the white square Right sides together and sew a quarter inch on the dotted line, stopping at the drawn, cutting line.

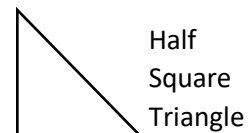
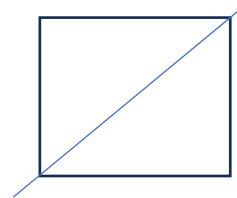


Mark the back of the white square.

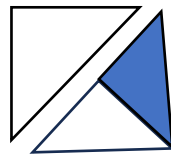
Cut on the line, and press open.



The two 6.25 inch squares are cut on the diagonal to yield four half square triangles.

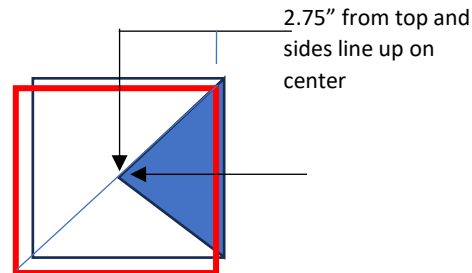


Take one quarter square triangle and pair it with one white half square triangle. Sew on the long side a quarter inch and press open.



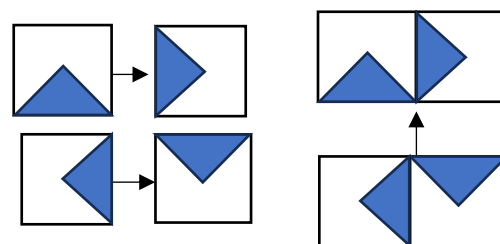
Repeat with the remaining Triangles.

Trim squares to 5.5 inches in this way. Line up the diagonal line on the ruler with The diagonal seam line. Put the 2.75 inch lines intersection on the ruler at the center of the point on the block, trim the right and top side. Rotate and using the trimmed sides line up the 5.5 inch line and trim the right and top.



Sew together as a four patch. Press center seam open.

This patch should measure 10.5 inches square.
