Moonlight Quilters - Due November 6

Economy Block

10.5" Unfinished

We will be using autumn colors in this traditional block.

1 5.5 inch sq. Fussy cut fruit, vegetables (pumpkins maybe)

2 4.75 inch sq. Support fabric in green.

2 6.25 inch sq. Background, light to medium cream

Frame the Center Block


Take both of the 4.75 green squares and cut them diagonally.



Fold the center square in half and crease at the mid point on both sides. Fold in the other direction and crease at the mid point on both sides.

Fold the each of the green triangles along the long side and crease at the mid point.

Using the creases match one green triangle to one side of the center square. Sew a ¼ inch seam and press away from the center. Attach the next triangle On the opposite side, matching the creases. Continue with the last two Triangles.




Trim to 7.5 inch square, careful to keep a .25 inch seam allowance at the middle points.

Frame the new block

Take both of the 6.25 inch squares of background pieces and cut them diagonally. Mark the center along the long side as above on all triangles. Match them at the center of each side at the creases and attach to each side of the block.

Trim to 10.5 inches, careful to keep a .25 inch seam allowance at the middle points as before.
