

Steps:

- 1) Align bindings with creases together and the quilt's final corner is folded to form a 45 degree angle.



- 2) Align the 45 degree line on the ruler with the press crease on the binding. Trace around the point of the ruler starting where the ruler touches the seam.



- 3) Sew on the line that you just drew. Pivoting at the crease in the center of the binding. Trim excess fabric and the binding "tails".



4) Turn the corner inside out.



Like anything, perfecting this technique requires practice so I recommend practicing on community quilts or cat cuddles or other projects before doing this on a precious quilt.
