

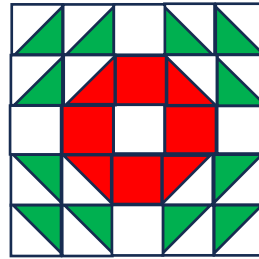
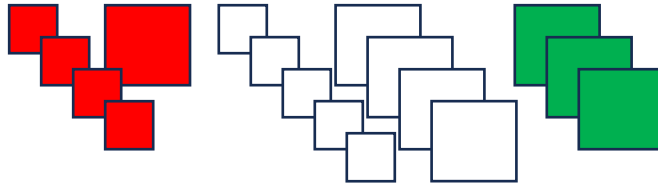

10.5" Unfinished

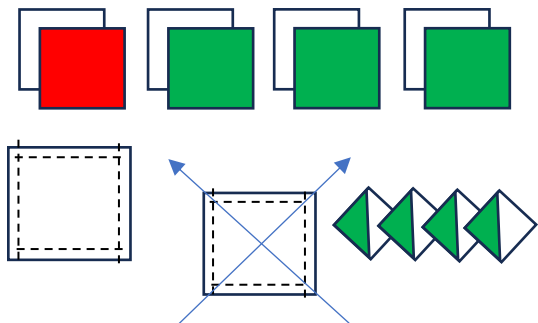
Colors to use are red, white and green.

| 4 | 2.5 inch sq. | Red |
| 1 | 4.5 inch sq. | Red |
| 5 | 2.5 inch sq. | White |
| 4 | 4.5 inch sq. | White |
| 3 | 4.5 inch sq. | Green |



Make half square triangles

Pair up the 4.5 inch squares, one white with the red, the remaining white with each of the green ones. Sew a quarter inch around the outside of each of these pairs. Cut on the diagonal in both directions. Each pair will yield four half square triangles (HST). Trim each HST to 2.5 inches square.



Layout the squares

Sew the squares together by rows using a scant quarter inch seam. Press the seams open.

Sew the rows together, also with a scant quarter inch seam, Matching the seams. Press the seams open.

This block should measure 10.5 inches square.
